

AP Alternative Assets, L.P. Announces Update on Unit Purchase Program

("AP Alternative Assets"; Euronext Amsterdam: AAA) announced today that in connection with its previously announced unit purchase program, it purchased 17,037 units of AAA during the period of June 25, 2010 through July 1, 2010. The units were purchased at an average price of \$6.11 per unit for total consideration of \$104,066. There are currently 121,315 units held in treasury by AAA.
